## Art Skills & Techniques

### Drawing:

- Creates simple representations of events people and objects
- Hold a pencil and other equipment and use it effectively
- Choose particular colours for purpose

### Painting:

- Explore what happens when they mix colours
- Experiment with colour and texture

### Collage:

- Use one handed tools correctly e.g. scissors
- Safely use and explore a variety of materials and tools.

### Printing:

- Experiment with printing: fingerprinting, hand printing and sponge printing

## Exploring & Evaluating

- Represent their own ideas, thoughts and feelings

Y1

## Art Skills & Techniques

### Drawing:

- Infill solid areas with colour pencils
- Begin to blend pastel colours by mixing & hatching

### Painting:

- Use black and white to create tints and tones
- Create texture using different thickness of paint

### Collage:

- Use glue and paste accurately
- Cut shapes accurately using scissors

### Printing:

- Take rubbings to show a range of textures
- Take a print from an object

## Exploring & Evaluating

- Respond to ideas to create a composition
- Demonstrate some knowledge about another artist and their work

Y2

## Art Skills & Techniques

### Drawing:

- Produce a growing range of patterns and textures with a single pencil
- Use a range of tones using a single pencil

### Painting:

- Mix secondary colours
- Use the brush to create a range of different marks

### Collage:

- Investigate texture with paper eg scrunching, folding

### Printing:

- Use simple relief printing
- Produce a clear printed image

## Exploring & Evaluating

- Learn about the work of other artists and the different techniques they used

# Art & Design Skills Progression KS2

Y5/6

## Art Skills & Techniques

### Drawing:

- Create depth through using perspective
- Draw the layout of the face and figure
- Draw the figure in motion
- Experiment with shading techniques including cross-hatching

### Painting:

- Paint large, flat areas using appropriate brushwork
- Understand the use of colours and how they are related eg. Hot and cold, complementary, contrasting

### Collage:

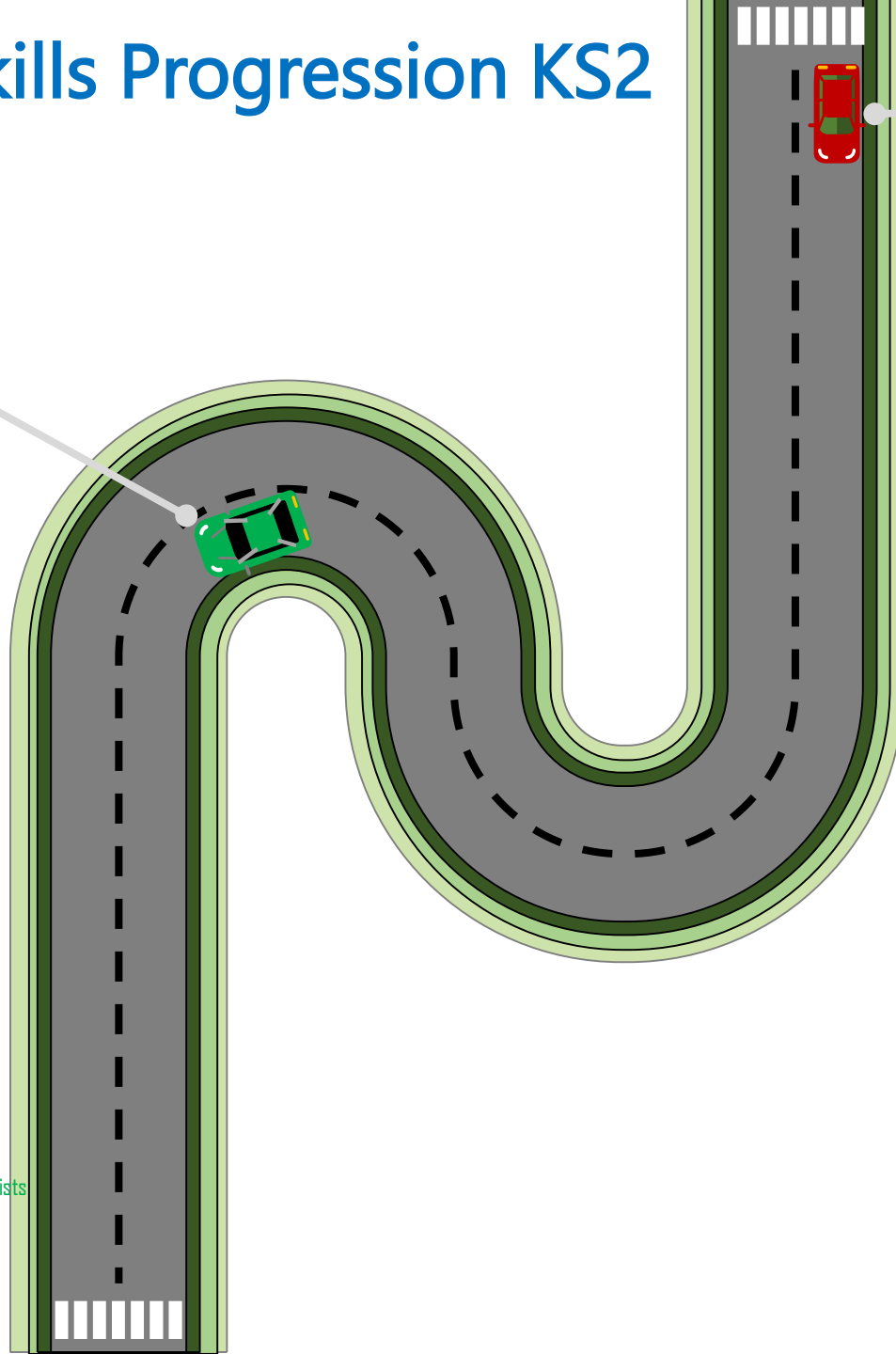
- Use folding, repeating and overlapping with different collage media
- Arrange and re-arrange colours, shapes and textures

### Printing:

- Make two colour prints & experiment with additional colours
- Combine prints

## Exploring & Evaluating

- Talk about the work of other artists in history including architects, artists
- Adapt and refine work to reflect their view of its purpose and meaning



Y3/4

## Art Skills & Techniques

### Drawing:

- Experiment with different types of line
- Create whole sketches including background
- Create texture using surface pattern

### Painting:

- Mix secondary colours
- Use the brush to create a range of different marks

### Collage:

- Investigate texture with paper eg scrunching, folding and ripping
- Use overlaying to build up layers

### Printing:

- Use simple relief printing
- Produce a clear printed image

## Exploring & Evaluating

- Create sketch books to record observations, review and revisit ideas
- Comment on similarities and differences in own and others' work
