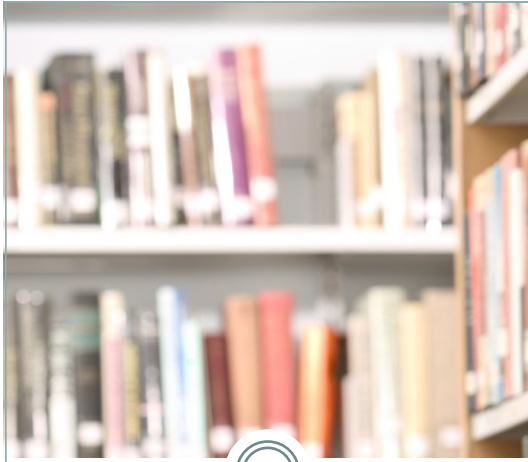

At ORTU Corringham Primary School we believe that good links between parents and the school helps your child with their enjoyment and increases the chances of them doing well.

We try hard to involve you in your child's education and school life in general. The more you know about your child's learning, the more you can offer support.

This leaflet highlights some of the ways we do this.

REPORTING TO PARENTS

REPORTS

Every term you will receive a report highlighting the achievement of your child in the core subjects.

At the end of the academic year you will receive a more detailed report stating how well your child has done in all subjects compared to national expectations. This will also include their attendance report for the year, statutory information (KS2, KS1, Phonics results) and targets.

PARENT-TEACHER MEETINGS

At parent-teacher meetings you can meet your child's class teacher to find out how they're doing. Their teacher will give you an outline of what your child is learning and how well they're keeping up. You'll be able to see recent examples of their work. The appointment will usually be for ten minutes and during the early evening. We have a formal meeting every term and also Open days throughout the year.

DROP-INS

All teachers are available to talk to parents at the end of the day or call the office for an appointment.

KEEP PARENTS INVOLVED

We have many ways to try and keep parents involved and informed about school life.

Our website has a huge amount of information for parents including our whole school calendar, curriculum information, how we assess the children and how you can support learning at home.

We have a weekly newsletter where the most recent information about the school is available. This is sent out to all parents via our email system and texting system, as well as on the web site.

Every year group will hold a parent's assembly during the year to show case their learning. It is lovely to see so many parents attending these.

To help parents we hold a series of parent workshops on a variety of topics including: assessment, curriculum, results, homework, reading, maths and many more.
